In doing this we will highlight the recent CWA ATPs for Dioxins and Furans in an effort to explain why an ATP is needed for CWA, but not SDWA or RCRA; this helps point out subtle differences between the programs, including required QC, that could affect you in your lab's operation. In addition, we will also discuss sampling, and potential issues with sample preservation.
